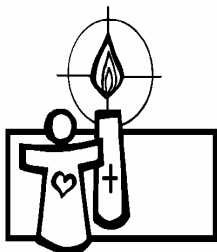

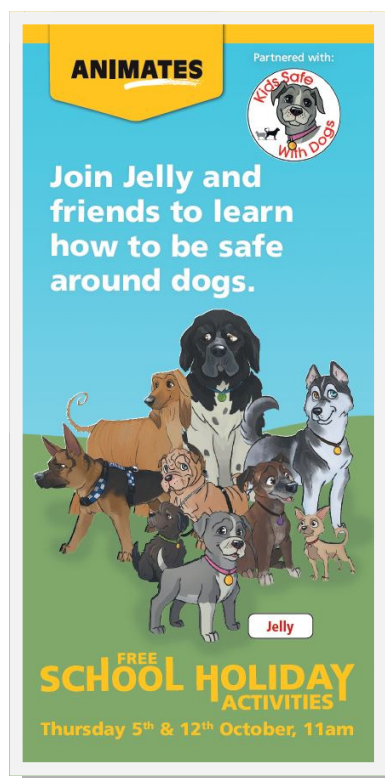


Jury Service

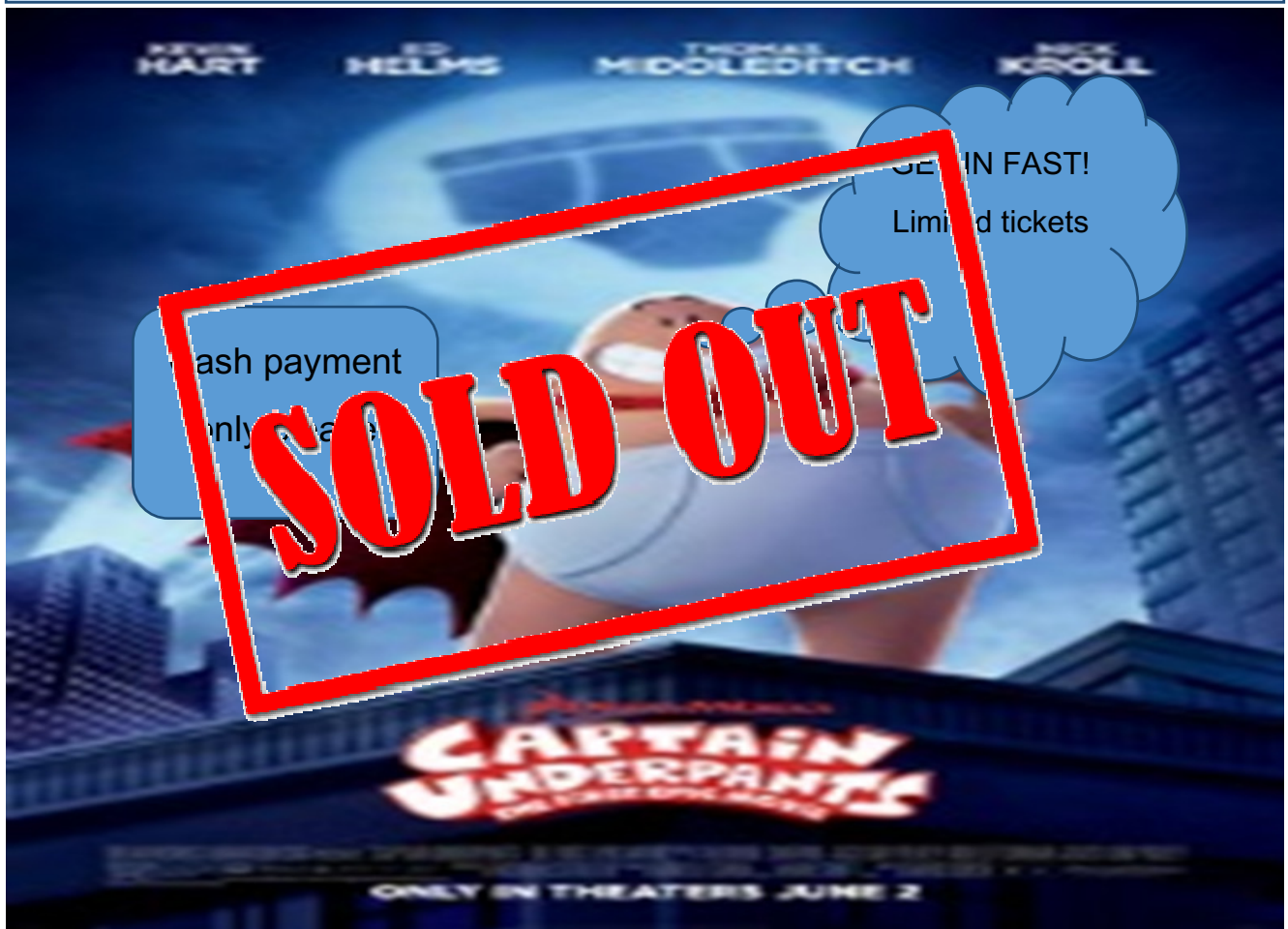

BANANA OAT COOKIES



- Ingredients:
- 2 ripe bananas – mashed
- 1 ¾ cup rolled oats
- ½ cup of either cranberries, raisins, nuts or seeds
