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Religious Instruction and Observances Policy

Rationale

The school is committed to the Catholic Faith development of its pupils.

Purposes

- 1. To promote the Catholic Faith through education programmes.
- 2. To provide opportunities for participation in Church celebration and observances.
- 3. To ensure appropriate time is provided for planning, implementing and evaluating the Religious Education Programme.
- 4. To provide resources which will support Religious Education Programme.
- 5. To encourage the Sacramental life of each individual in the school.

Guidelines

- 1. The R.E. Programmes will be taught at the relevant levels in the school as laid down by National R.E. Curriculum
- 2. The school will support all Sacramental programmes run in the Parish.
- 3. Up to two and a half hours per week will be timetabled for teaching of the Religious Education Programme according to class level.
- 4. All teachers are expected to participate in Religious Education Professional Development.
- 5. Teachers in tagged positions are expected to work towards a recognised Religious Education accreditation.
- 6. Teachers and pupils will observe times of prayer during each school day.
- 7. Religious Education should value and reflect bicultural relationships within Aotearoa society and its multi-cultural nature.
