

INTRASCHOOL REPRESENTATIVE SPORTS POLICY

Rationale

School Representative Sport provides opportunities for children to develop physical skills. It encourages pride in the school, strengthens self-esteem and promotes team spirit for the enjoyment of all participants. As a Catholic school it should be remembered we are a Catholic school which espouses Gospel values and the individuals representing the school should act in a Christian manner

Purposes

1. To provide opportunities regardless of pupil abilities to participate in sport.

2. Show a mutual respect and concern for others while participating in and observing physical activities.

- 3. Participate in a variety of games and sports emphasising team or group activities.
- 4. To develop a positive attitude towards participation in sports activities.
- 5. To participate effectively as a member of a team or group.

Guidelines

- 1. The school is to provide opportunities for children to prepare and participate in school representative sport.
- 2. The Five Ideals of Fair Play identified by the Hillary Commission are to be promoted.
 - 1. Respect the Rules
 - 2. Respect the officials and accept their decisions
 - 3. Respect your opponent
 - 4. Give everybody an equal chance to participate
 - 5. Maintain your self control at all times.
 - a) no bad language/loss of temper
 - b) no unnecessary contact with own or opposing players
 - c) no refusal to play
 - d) no "refereeing" of your own
- 3. Coaches, parents and participants are to adhere to the principles of
 - a) winning is fun but losing is not a reason for derogatory commentsb) positive comments help a player to do better.
- 4. Uniforms specific to each representative sport must be worn.
- 5. Equal rotation for all players is mandatory.
- 6. Coaches / Managers must accept the varying skill abilities of all players.
- 7. Coaches / Managers / Parents / Caregivers must sign the Policy as a formal agreement.
- 8. When organising sports trips inform parents at least 7 days prior to the day.
- 9. Trips inside the city boundary need only the Principal's approval.
- 10. Teams are to be entered by the school, not by coaches.
- 11. Coaches/managers have a responsibility to provide adequate supervision until children are collected by parents/caregivers.
