

Boys Summer Uniform


Grey polo shirt with school monogram, grey summer shorts. Black or brown sandals.

School History

When the school opened in 1955 the childrens' playing field was sited where the church stands today. The rest of the land around the school was undeveloped. Many parent working bees were organised to complete drainage work, painting, pathways and fencing.

Two Sisters of the Missions, who lived at St Mary's Convent, were driven each day, to and from school, by the parish priest Father O'Sullivan.

When the school first opened the roll was just over 50 students and included boys and girls from Primer 1 (New Entrants) to Form 2 (Year 8). By 1958 the school roll had grown to approximately 100.

As time went by the boys left SPC at the end of Std. 3 (Year 5) and went to an all boys school Marist Intermediate. This arrangement spanned many years until Marist's closure in 1989.


