

#### Calendar Art



## Kiwi Maths & English Exams

#### **Kiwi Mathematics and English Exams**

Last term we selected students from Year 5/6 and Year 7/8 to participate in the Kiwi Mathematics and English competitions. Exams are based on New Zealand curriculum items relevant to each year level. The data collected from all the students who took part nationally in the current year is separated into the year levels, Year 5, Year 6, Year 7, Year 8, Year 9 and Year 10, for each competition. The national data for each competition subject area and year level is then ranked and the cut-off between grades is calculated using the percentiles for each subject area and year level. A student who scored less than the 50th percentile receives a grade of 'Participation'. A student who scored in the top 50% of scores receives a grade of 'Achieved'. Merit is within the top 25%, Excellence is within the top 9.5% and Distinction is within the top 0.5%

#### **Boys Summer Uniform**


Grey polo shirt with school monogram, grey summer shorts. Black or brown sandals.
