

The Kiwivolley League provides a great opportunity for our primary and intermediate athletes to play and development their volleyball skills in a fun environment.

The games are played 4-a-side and mixed genders on badminton sized courts. The Kiwivolley League runs over 4 weeks starting from Wednesday 22nd November and finishing on Wednesday 20th September. Entries close Friday 17th November.

Our Kiwivolley programme is characterised by enhancing overall understanding of the volleyball fundamentals and general athletic development. Improving basic movement abilities such as agility, balance, speed, and coordination, while improving fundamental movement skills such as running, jumping, passing and spiking, and developing physical literacy are the primary focus.

Volleyball is a popular sport and it's great to have this opportunity to try it out! Teams are between 4 and 6 players, so gather your friends together and let's go!
