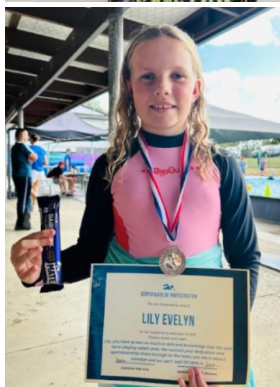
TERM 1 SPORTS FEES - ARE NOW OVERDUE
