




Ben Seward, the first ever passenger boarding the van for the seniors' visit to the Rototuna Library on Wednesday. It looks like Tyler was second!

The Rototuna library provided the opportunity for 25 of our seniors to participate in a one-hour VR experience embarking on an underwater journey without ever leaving the library. During the hands-on STEM workshop, the students explored marine ecosystems through the immersive power of virtual reality (VR) using Meta Quest headsets.
