

- The Parents are required to come on the same Tuesday and Wednesday from 6:00pm to 7:00pm









## Sausage Sizzle

This term we are compiling stories, photos and artefacts of our Saint Peter Chanel history. Each class will be learning the skills of questioning, interviewing and recording information.


We would like to interview past students about their time at SPC. You may be asked about learning, play, activities, uniforms, the environment etc.
